Mission :

Inspired by Swami Vivekananda concern for the less fortunate, the Societies mission is the alleviation of human suffering — a lofty charge with endless possibilities. To translate this vast goal into manageable and meaningful day-to-day practice, the board of directors has selected priority areas upon which to focus its efforts, including Basic Health Care, Food Security, Economic Empowerment, Blindness, Water Development, Early Childhood Development, and Education, Domestic Violence, Homelessness, and Substance Abuse.

Objectives :

- Taking part in promoting education for the children hailing from destitute families
- Making people aware of the rights, duties, responsibilities as an individual, a villager, a citizen
- Providing preventive, promotive and curative health care services for the people in general and women and children in specific
- Empowering the rural women through micro-finance and micro entrepreneurship development programme
- Imparting vocational training for rural youth with a view to making them self - supportive including acquiring skill suited to their needs, priorities and capabilities
- To provide support to the vulnerable person materially and emotionally
- To initiate an appropriate early child hood development and rehabilitation of the children with disabilities including older persons
- Promotion of local resources to function as self-sustaining development units
- Integration of crop cultivation, agri - horticulture, agro - forestry, livestock rearing and fish culture and increase their production
- Building confidence amongs the target groups to create their own resources and recycle those in sequential manner for sustainability
- Overall improvement of socio-economic conditions of the target community including basic health measures, education, empowerment, etc.

PROGRAMMES:-

Legal Awareness Programme -

As per our experience and observation regarding our voluntary social service it has been seen that awareness plays a vital role in generating consciousness among the people for a cause to achieve a aspire.

Following are some steps taken by JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY in creating realization about awaking people regarding their thoughts, to change their basic myths, ignorance and etc.

Social Programme :-

The JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY runs various activities for social welfare purposes. These mainly include Help to Poor Students, Help for Poor Widow, Cloth & Books Distribution, Help to Married. Other than this education for women, awareness generation projects for rural and poor women, family counseling centers, crèches for the children of working and ailing mothers, etc.

In addition to the above, the other activities of the JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY are as under :-

1. Orientation Training to the functionaries of other voluntary organizations
2. Training to the organizers of Awareness Generation Programme.
3. Demonstration Project
4. Socio Economic Programme

Beside above in time to time, JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY has stepped into or rather taken various social programmes voluntarily with the help and support of local stakeholders.

Training Programme -

Women & Youths of the area are the most neglected. Their present social & economic status does not allow them to fight for their legal entitlements. CBS based concern with the continued high mortality and morbidity of women, lack of demonstrable programmes in implementation resolutions and programme for the improvement of women, socio-economic. For the empowerment of women CBS has designed above a vocational Training and I.G.P. for down trodden women. At least 50 women are getting meaningful benefit from this programme. Rural women have been equipped themselves and now stand on their own feet through earning money.

Following are some of the programmes which JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY has been taking to make the local youth understand and take steps for developing their own entrepreneurship programme by taking vocational training from our training centre for self dependency. The programme is mainly of two phases i.e., 7 to 15 days each depending upon the length of the programme needs.

Education Programme -

Education is the building block of a proud nation. Lots of research has been done till date regarding where we are standing in providing basic education. It is surprising that after so many researches we are still reluctant to make a difference regarding this simple word know to be education. We neither tried nor able to solve the problem related to education and why there is still big difference from the perspective of an urban child having education and rural child having education. Both of them are having education but in a longer term we will see eventually the rural child will ultimately drop out because of numerous reasons. One is obviously is poverty other is pressure from the child's family in opting out for easy income. This ultimately results to insecure future where the child grows up and follows the same steps as his or her mother taken for him.

Our formal and non-formal education has proven its effectiveness in the society.

A mass awareness generation followed by a systematic procedure of attracting peoples to the education sector will eventually bring a great difference in the scenario.

In this regards JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY helps by distributing books to the needy meritorious students, including free pre primary education and including giving emphasize in our ethnic socio - cultural mode of education in form of "Brotochary Programme".

Proper awareness in regards to education can play a vital responsibility in making a change in the community in regards to various social issues it can be of health, education, gender issues and etc.

Health Programme:

Each year, millions of children and mothers could be saved through improved access to basic health interventions.

Those who most desperately need them - the rural poor - live in remote villages where the cost of reaching them could be five times greater than urban areas.

JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY frequently conducts Health check-ups at remote rural areas, where medical treatment would not be otherwise possible.

JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY major role is:

- mobilizing the patients from remote villages to camp site through van transportation,
- providing food packets to all the patients,
- providing logistic support to camp doctors and their team,
- arranging the cataract patients to reach the eye hospital to undergo cataract surgery and take them back to their villages after surgery,
- providing dark glasses and follow-up medicines to the cataract operated patients.

Participation at the camps and all the surgeries are absolutely free of cost for the patients.

Cultural Activities -

The culture of India has been shaped by the long history of India, its unique geography and the absorption of customs, traditions and ideas from some of its neighbours as well as by preserving its ancient heritages, which were formed during the Indus Valley Civilization and evolved further during the Vedic age, rise and decline of Buddhism, Golden age, Muslim conquests and European colonization. India's great diversity of cultural practices, languages, customs, and traditions are examples of this unique co-mingling over the past five millennium. The various religions and traditions of India that were created by these amalgamations have influenced other parts of the world too.

It is vital for an individual to excel not only intellectually, but also socially, physically, and emotionally, which can only be achieved by linking education with culture, and at the same time keeping pace with rapidly changing technology. For education to be effective and result-oriented, it has to be culture based, and it must take into account the cognitive, emotional and spiritual needs of the student.

The JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY recognised the need of culture-based education. The role of culture in developing democratic citizenship is the prime requirement for a developing country. Knowledge of culture plays a prominent role in democratic thinking: a democratic citizen is known for his ability to sift truth from false and he/she is more receptive to new ideas. True culture also brings clarity of thought, compassion and concern for mankind and is a basis for human rights.

In believing this simple truth, JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY has taken up many initiatives to promote and encourage our rich culture mainly based in the rural areas.

Likewise, JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY give emphasize on folk culture Folk culture refers related the localized lifestyle of a culture. It is usually handed down through oral tradition related to a sense of community, and demonstrates the "old ways" over novelty. Folk culture is quite often imbued with a sense of place. If its elements are copied by, or removed to, a foreign locale, they will still carry strong connotations of their original place of creation. It is a very effective and popular cultural media for disseminating messages among the community people.

As per documentation, JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY organized 233 (frequency) folk song events on different issues and 26 popular theatres during this reporting period. A total of 30000 (app) community people participated in such programs. JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY tried to develop this program as a separate identity in organization level.

Sports Programme -

A large number of tournaments and competitions for sportspersons of all age groups are being conducted by JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY every year.

To promote competitive spirit and a 'killer instinct' among rural youth, Level Rural Sports Meets are being conducted in the South 24 Parganas region.

With a view to identifying young talent in sports and games at the school level, the "Catch Them Young Tournaments" are conducted every year by the JOYNAGAR KANSARIPARA MAA SITALA SEVA SAMITY for boys and girls below 14 years of age, in the following disciplines 1. Athletics, 2. Football and 3. Kabaddi.

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
